About the Club

The Dunsborough and Districts Country Club (the Club) is a sporting facility and meeting place for members, the local community, and visitors to the region. Everyone is welcome to use the sporting facilities or relax and socialise with a meal from our commercial kitchen and refreshments from our fully licenced bar.

The Club was opened in 1973 and from 1982 it operated on a Club Liquor Licence. In 2018 the Club changed this to a Restricted Tavern Licence, which opened up the Club to visitors without having to be signed-in by a member.

The Club mainly operates as a sport and recreation facility hosting six main sports: bowls, tennis, croquet, golf, mountain biking, and mind sports (canasta and mah-jong). It also hosts functions such as weddings, birthdays, business meetings, wakes, community club dinners, and entertainment.

The Club's venue includes:

- well maintained sporting facilities and booking systems;
- a fully licenced, air-conditioned bar with seating for over 150 guests;
- a fully equipped, commercial grade kitchen;
- male and female amenities, including change rooms and showers;
- a large alfresco area with barbecue facilities, and seating which overlooks the bowls and croquet greens;
- a gated, toddlers' play area with sunshades;
- free on-site parking and disabled access;
- several function areas equipped with TVs and other audio-visual equipment;
- an office area with a meeting room, telephone, printer, and computer with Internet access, and
- a bus-stop next to the clubhouse car park.

For many years, the Club has been acknowledged by Clubs WA as a leader and has won numerous awards in various categories, including (to name a few):

- Best Sport and Recreation Club;
- Club of the Year, and
- Best Function Facility.

Recent local population growth and improved sporting facilities have seen the Club's membership grow to over 850. These numbers increase significantly with visitors during the summer months and holiday periods. To illustrate this:

- An annual mountain bike event in April attracts over 1,000 riders plus their support groups and spectators, and
- The group's festival event in June attracts many hundreds of families.

The Club is an incorporated, not for profit organisation governed by an elected Management Committee and operated by a group of enthusiastic volunteers. As such, the Club relies on and appreciates the generosity of its sponsors.
